Tips for taking great photos

File size and format

Less is more when it comes to file size, try to keep them below 640x480 pixels, this is the largest they will generally appear online and when they are too large they can have problems loading. As for the file format, please send jpgs.

Orientation

Please only send landscape photos instead of portrait, where the width of the photo is bigger than the height.





External photos

It's best to get front and rear view images of the property (if possible). And don't forget to keep parking spaces clear and the garden tidy. If you can wait for a sunny day, that would be even better.



Internal photos

Take photos at the brightest time of day if you can. Keep all curtains and blinds open, turn all of the lights on and aim to keep the camera flash set to off. Watch out for mirrors and anything reflective as your image will reflect.



Declutter / keep it clean

Aim for a lived in / homely feel but try to de-clutter where possible. Keep kitchen work surfaces clear, laundry out of sight and the toilet seat down.





Quantity

If possible a minimum of 5 photos but maximum of 10.
